The Blair Witch Project isn't a horror film experience on par with 'The Exorcist' or 'The Shining,' but that's not a fair comparison. It's an experience all its own. [The Blair Witch Project is] the most effective and unsettling horror movie in quite a long time.

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The Blair Witch Project is not a typical film that the typical cinema-going public would normally be exposed to. The camera-work is jerky, the dialogue repetitive and inane and the action virtually nonexistent.
