Furthermore, as stated in section 14 (c) of the Act, the Copyright Law gives the right holders the sole authority to do or authorise someone else to do a replic a of their copyrighted work.

Another potential legal issue with memes is defamation. If a meme co ntains false information that harms a person's reputation, it could potentia lly be considered defamatory. For example, if someone creates a meme that falsely accuses a person of a crime, that person may sue for defamation.
