oldem, also known as Short Deck Poker, is a variation of Texas Hold

oldem that uses 36 cards instead of the standard 52. That's right, all

cards below six are removed, leaving us with a stripped-down deck tha

t offers a new and exciting challenge for poker enthusiasts. <p>

<p>Now that we've got that covered, let's move on to ho

w the game is played. Each player places an ante, similar to Texas Hold

and then receives two private cards. The dealer then places a blind

bet, and the players can choose to call, raise, or fold. The

twist? The flop, turn, and river are community cards, just like in Texas Hold

em. However, since the deck is smaller, the chances of making stro

nger hands are higher! <p>

<p>But wait, there's more! Since the deck is smaller, the ranking of hands changes slightly. In 6+ Hold

em, a flush beats a full house!

<p> That's right, if two players have a flush, the winner

is determined by the highest card in the flush.
