[Percutaneous endoscopic gastrostomy \(PEG\) is a type of feeding tube which is inserted through the skin of the abdomen into the stomach during an endoscopy. You may need a PEG if food, drink and medicines cannot reach your stomach \(for example, if you can't swallow properly\).](#)

It can be put in via two methods: PEG or RIG. PEG stands for Percutaneous Endoscopic Gastrostomy - inserted via a telescope down the food pipe. RIG stands for Radiologically Inserted Gastrostomy - inserted using X-ray guidance after having barium placed inside the stomach.
