<p&gt;Worldview Entertainment was founded in &#129522; 2007 by Chairman and CEO, Christopher Woodrow,[1] and Maria Cestone. Molly Conners joined the company in 2009 as COO. Worldview &#129522; Entertainment signed with Creative Artists Agency (CAA) in 2010 and has since become the agency&#39;s top film finance and production &#129522; client. Sarah E. Johnson, daughter of Franklin Resources Chairman, Charles B. Johnson, became a partner and investor in the company &#129522; in 2011. Worldview established a four-yearR\$30 million credit facility with Comerica in 2013 to provide debt financing for the company&#39;s &#129522; films, which coincided with the infusion ofR\$40 million in new equity from existing investors. TheR\$70 million doubled the company&#39;s capital &#129522; base.& lt;/p&gt;

<p&gt;The company&#39;s first film was William Friedkin&#39;s black comedy, K iller Joe, which it financed along with Voltage Pictures in 2010. &#129522; The film premiered at the 2011 Venice Film Festival before making its North America n debut at the Toronto International Film &#129522; Festival, where it was sold domestically to LD Entertainment in one of the biggest sales at the festival. T he film &#129522; was distributed theatrically in the summer of 2012, with star Matthew McConaughey receiving a nomination for an Independent Spirit Award &#12
